

New Basic Rubric Guidelines for Health 30 Written Papers

“A” papers will include the following:

1. A minimum of 3 sources cited, not all from web sources
2. A minimum of 3 pages NOT INCLUDING sources, title page
3. Very creative – this might include photos, You Tube video links, case examples, personal interviews, homemade guide books, and more
4. Information is presented clearly, accurately, and professionally
 - a. Includes perfect to near-perfect spelling and grammar
 - b. Logical progression of ideas from topic paragraph to closing paragraph

“B” papers will include the following:

1. A minimum of 2 sources
2. A minimum of 2-2.5 pages NOT INCLUDING sources, title page
3. Some creativity
4. Information is presented clearly, accurately, and professionally
 - a. Includes mostly perfect spelling and grammar
 - b. Logical progression of ideas from topic paragraph to closing paragraph

“C” papers will include the following:

1. Use of 1 source material (such as class text only or web only)
2. A minimum of 2 pages NOT INCLUDING sources, title page
3. Lacks creativity
4. Information presented is fairly clear, accurate, and professional: paper is still readable
 - a. Includes fairly good spelling and grammar
 - b. Logical progression of ideas from topic paragraph to closing paragraph

Note: The single best piece of advice I can give you is to proofread your papers! This is the biggest mistake students make. One way to do this is to ask someone to read it and explain your paper to you or another is to read it aloud to yourself. However you do it, please do it for yourself. Good luck!
